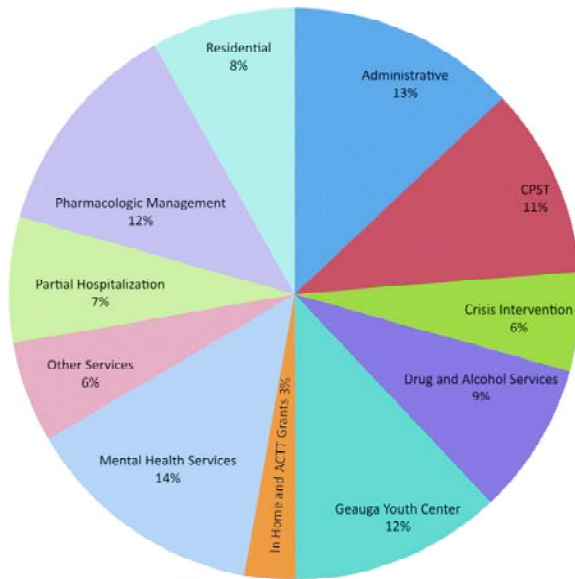

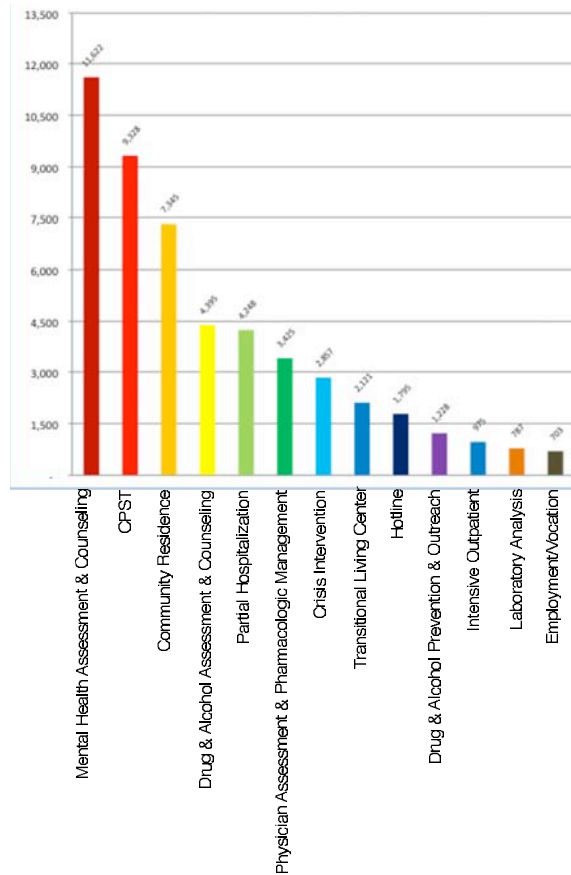

Fiscal Year 2010 in Review

Looking Back: Fiscal Year 2010 (July 1, 2009 – June 30, 2010) began with great concern as our nation's economy continued to decline. The worst part of the recession came at the beginning of the fiscal year and while anemic signs of recovery started to appear in the spring of 2010, unemployment remained very high and the business environment was difficult at best. While things were better in Geauga County the difference was only one of degree, and for those who lost jobs and homes, there was no difference at all. 2010 was the second year of the State of Ohio's biennial budget so the chaos that was observed the year before had diminished, but negotiation and adjustments in relation to declining revenues at the state level continued and put downward pressure on funds available for mental health and addiction recovery services.

In the midst of this gloom, Ravenwood entered its 44th year of operation and with the support and effective advocacy of the Geauga County Board of Mental Health and Recovery Services, and the generosity of the United Way Services of Geauga County, we were able to maintain all services with only minor adjustments. As in the past we continued to provide focused and intensive services for persons with severe and persistent mental illness and those with severe emotional disorders. But we also started to see a new type of problem and client that reflected the economic distress of the times. Increasingly the individuals who presented in crisis did so in the throes of personal and career upheaval brought on by financial wreckage that surrounded them. Ravenwood provided over fifty thousand units of service to over 2000 Geauga County residents in 2010. We could not repair the foreclosures and fractured retirement plans that we heard about. But we were grateful to be in place to provide respite and treatment for casualties of the Great Recession.
